Each student is responsible to have all of the supplies listed on the first day of school and throughout the year. Thank you. Please make sure all supplies are clearly labeled with the student's name.

- 2 packages of 200 sheets white lined college ruled paper
- 1 five-subject spiral notebook
- 1 large three-ring binder or accordion file folder with at least eight sections
- 1 1/4 inch 3-ring binder (non-flimsy) any color (for music)
- 2 one-subject spiral notebooks for reading and language arts
- 1 package of eight dividers (for three-ring binder)
- 4 packages of blue or black pens
- 1 package of red correcting pens
- 4 boxes of #2 pencils
- 1 personal non-electric pencil sharpener
- 1 box of markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 2 highlighters
- 2 black Sharpie markers
- 1 large pink pearl eraser
- 1 ruler – metric and customary
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 large glue sticks
- 1 supply box
- 2 packs of 3 x 3 post-it note (four pads in each package)
- 2 packs of 3 x 5 ruled index cards
- 1 hole-punched pencil pouch for the binder
